

CITE gains approval to deliver BTEC qualifications

CITE is now an Approved Centre with the awarding body Edexcel, delivering BTEC and NVQ qualifications. We are already an Approved Centre with City and Guilds, so the new suite of Edexcel qualifications expands the portfolio of accredited training that CITE can now offer.

The first courses have already been delivered, leading to the Edexcel WorkSkills BTEC Award in this instance. This followed an intensive mapping exercise where our existing lessons plans and materials were adapted to reflect the WorkSkills standards.
